Objective: The committee has been constituted by the principal for implementing NEP regulations in B.Tech.as well as MBA. The committee remains functional for entire Academic year.

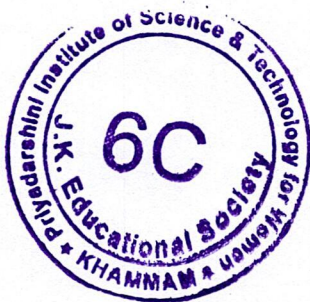
About the committee:

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Institutional Preparedness for NEP

1. Multidisciplinary/interdisciplinary: 	The Vision of National Education Policy, to provide high quality education to develop human resources in our Nation, is well taken by the PRIW. A discussion among the faculty members were initiated on the key principles of NEP such as diversity for all curriculum and pedagogy with technological innovations in teaching and learning, encouraging logical decision making and innovation, critical thinking and creativity. Academic programmes are designed to include Multidisciplinary /Interdisciplinary courses as electives mentioned by JNTUH Curriculum. All programmes are designed in such a way that students get maximum flexibility to choose elective courses (open electives) offered by other Departments. It can be said that the PRIW is proactively working towards implementation of the suggestions given in the NEP. Faculty members are encouraged to take up the interdisciplinary or community development research work by identifying the problems in the society.
2. APAAR (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) ID	PRIW is very much interested in the concept of APAAR which is a government endeavour to part of "One Nation, One Student ID" initiative in India. Serves as a central repository for all a student's academic information, including their academic records, achievements, and credits. PRIW follows a choice-based credit system for all of its programmes as per the JNTUH Curriculum
